

The Joseph William Seward Memorial Scholarship was established under the Lewis Claiborne Seward Trust to provide financial assistance to further the higher education of high school graduates of high scholastic standing.

Eligibility

- Graduating High School Seniors in the City of Petersburg, County of Dinwiddie, or the County of Prince George, Virginia
- *Family members and employees of the committee are not eligible for this scholarship.*

Application Process

First time Applicants must submit the following:

1. Completed application form.
2. Write a short paragraph stating your career goals.
3. Write a brief paragraph explaining your need for this scholarship.
4. List honors and awards received (indicate name, date and reason award was given).
5. List all extracurricular activities (school and community).
6. Submit an Official Transcript (SEALED).
7. File the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and submit a copy of the pages 1 and 2 of the Student Aid Report (SAR). (Internet print offs are acceptable as long as they contain the “Confirmation Stamp” **AND** the “Estimated Family Contribution (EFC)”)

Renewal Applicants must submit the following:

1. Completed application form.
2. Submit an Official Transcript (SEALED).
3. File the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and submit a copy of the pages 1 and 2 of the Student Aid Report (SAR). (Internet print offs are acceptable as long as they contain the “Confirmation Stamp” **AND** the “Estimated Family Contribution (EFC)”)

Selection Process

The recipients of this scholarship will be determined by the Joseph William Seward Memorial Scholarship Committee. Consideration will be given to character, intelligence, scholastic record, and extracurricular activities. Scholarship recipients will be notified by June 30th. To be eligible for renewal of this scholarship, the applicant must reapply next year and maintain at least a 3.0 average.

Additional information on FAFSA and SARs

To be considered for the Joseph William Seward Scholarship you must file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). You may obtain a FAFSA form from your guidance counselor, the student aid officer of your prospective college, or via the internet at <http://www.fafsa.ed.gov/> . We suggest that you file your FAFSA via the internet as this is faster than filing paper from by mail. You must attach to this application a copy of pages 1 and 2 of the Student Aid Report (SAR). If you file via the internet, you may submit a copy of the confirmation showing that your application has been submitted, giving the “Confirmation Stamp” **AND** the EFC (Estimated Family Contribution). For your application to be considered, you must submit the EFC for your family, as determined by FAFSA.
